University of Kansas, West Campus

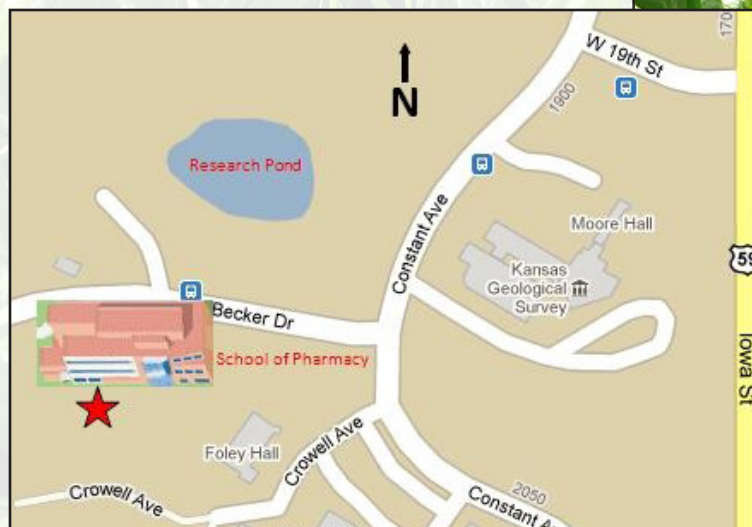

The public is invited to participate in the planting of a new educational medicinal garden designed by the faculty and staff of the KU Native Medicinal Plant Research Program. The garden will have five themed beds of medicinal plants, about 70 species total. The event will open with a short presentation about the new garden and about KU's first medicinal garden, planted by the School of Pharmacy in the 1920s.

Where to go: From 19th and Iowa, go west on 19th one block and turn left onto Constant Ave. Just past the research pond, take the first right onto Becker Drive. The building is on the left. The garden will be on the south side at the patio. Pharmacy lots 227 and 228, plus the Park and Ride lot, will open at 2:30 for event parking.
